

Instructor Fast Track (IFT)

What is Instructor Fast Track (IFT) and how do I enroll in an IFT course?

Instructor Fast Track (IFT) training is an opportunity to gain skills qualification with little or no instruction. This rigorous option is provided for Instructors with requisite subject knowledge and skills who would not benefit from a full Instructor training session. Only candidates with prior subject matter knowledge can enroll in an IFT course.

To enroll in an IFT course, the prospective Instructor needs to contact their Instructor Training Center (ITC).

Enrollment Prerequisites: Hold a current Industry Certification

IFT Completion Standards:

- A candidate proves proficiency by successfully completing the SBA specific to the IFT course (The minimum passing score for the IFT SBA is 80 %.)
- The Packet Tracer SBA is not to be used for the IFT.
- A candidate who does not pass the SBA is not passed from the IFT class and must enter a full Instructor training class.
- The prospective Instructor needs to successfully complete the IFT class before they will be qualified to create a Student class and deliver instruction.

Upon successful completion of a Fast Track course, the prospective Instructor must contact the Support Desk for confirmation of their prerequisites. The prospective Instructor must provide the following information to the Support Desk:

- Name of the IFT course
- Proof of Industry Certification
 - CSCO ID for CCNA and CCNP
 - A+ Certification for IT Essentials. (Please refer to our FAQ titled 'Obtain Proof of CompTIA Industry Certification' for instructions)

After verification of the prerequisites, the Support Desk will update the prospective Instructor's profile to give them the ability to create Student courses.
